<p>NOTE: Continuous Enrollment assumes that all current students at TBS are returning unless notification is received in writing through the Admissions Office. The March 2017 billing statement will be sent to all current families and will include a Continuous Enrollment fee of \$150/student (\$500/family max). Students not returning must notify the Admissions Office of their decision before March 1 to avoid paying the non-refundable Continuous Enrollment fee. TRANSPORTATION: A TBS bus route runs each school day from the Spanaway, Graham area to TBS. Bus fees are a flat rate monthly cost; transportation costs are not pro-rated. The bus fees for the 2017-18 school year are as follows:

- **ROUND TRIP:** \$100 per month for one child; \$50 per month for each additional child
- **ONE WAY (Mornings or Afternoons):** \$75 per month per child
- **OCCASIONAL RIDER:** \$5 per ride (one way)

Note: Transportation for TBS half-day PK students is to school in the morning only. No Preschool transportation is available.

SPORTS: \$125 per sport, per season for all participating secondary students

The sports fee is paid each season that a student participates in a sport. (This is not a one-time fee that covers all sports for the entire year). Students will not be permitted to participate in the next season's sport until the fee from the previous season is paid in full. Students who drop out after the first five practices will be charged 50% of the sports fee. The entire fee will be non-refundable after the first game of the season, even if the student is ineligible to play due to grades.

LUNCH: Hot lunch is available to purchase for \$4.25. Beverages are available at an additional cost. Snacks and a la carte food items are also available for secondary students to purchase. The Student Center serves lunch each full day of school. Lunch service is not available on early dismissal days. Lunch and a la carte items are to be paid for in full at the time of purchase using cash, check, or funds pre-loaded onto the family's RenWeb account. No lunch items may be charged by students.

INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT CENTER (ISC): This service is available to students in grades 2-12 who meet eligibility requirements pertaining to unique learning needs not met in a standard classroom setting. Diagnostic testing and administrative recommendation are required for placement in ISC. **Please Note:** *ISC is NOT a Title 1 Special Education program. Diagnostic and program fees apply and are billed separately from tuition. For specific pricing, please request an ISC brochure.*

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE (BASC): The cost is \$2.25 per 15 minutes and is billed separately from tuition. BASC is available before and after school for full-day students in grades PK-6. Before school care is available on normal school days from 7:00-7:45 a.m. and after school care is available from 2:30-5:30 p.m. On early dismissal days, after school care is open until 2:30 p.m. A late fee of \$1.00 per minute per child is assessed if a child is picked up after the scheduled BASC closing time.

ADDITIONAL: There may be additional fees associated with specific courses. AP and Honors courses are assessed an annual class fee of \$100, which is due in the spring for the following school year. Concurrent Credit and Fine Arts fees may be assessed and are evaluated on a class by class basis. All efforts are made to keep these fees as low as possible while still covering expenses.
