Item	Description/ Specifics	Quantity
New King James Bible	Needs both Old and New Testaments and a concordance. Study Bible preferred. Students will be required to bring this with them to every class. NIV and ESV translations are also acceptable.	1
Three-ring binder	2 inches or larger, general subject (replace as needed)- the typical student goes through 2-3 a year.	1
Notebook dividers	At least six- preferably plastic	1
Calculator	7 th graders: a scientific calculator. 8 th graders: Pre Algebra students need a scientific calculator but all Algebra students need to have a TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator (If you do not already have a calculator, please purchase a TI-84. You may use a TI-83 if you already have it, but a TI-84 is preferred.) This calculator will be used for science and math throughout high school. Please label with student's name.	1
Notebook paper	College ruled. **Bring one package at a time and keep the extra at home. No colored paper	5 packs**
Pencils with erasers	#2 pencils/mechanical pencils with #2 lead- **Bring 4-6 to school and keep the extras at home.	**At least 4 dz
Ball point pens	Blue or black ink only- **Bring 2-4 to school and keep the extras at home.	**6
Composition notebook	Each one will be used solely for one class/subject	4
Spiral notebook	Spiral notebook that is 3 hole punched and can fit in the binder	1
Pencil pouch	Should have three holes for fitting in the binder.	1
Highlighters	Assorted package (at least three different colors)	1
Library Card	A current card from King or Pierce County or Tacoma Public Library. Bring card or number on the first day.	1
Kleenex	Large/family size containers.	1 of each
Disinfectant wipes	Large/family size containers.	1 of each
Baby wipes	Large/family size containers.	1 of each
Dry Erase markers	Blue, brown, red or black in color.	2
3-pronged report folder	These are used during the year and should be kept at home.	3
Glue stick	Elmer's or UHU recommended	1

12 inch ruler	Must have inches and millimeters	1
Colored pencils	12 count or more – bring to class when notified – keep extras in your locker until needed.	1
USB Drive	Any size or brand, (minimum 2GB recommended)	1
Graph paper	¼" squares	1 pack
3"x5" cards 100 per pack	Lined index cards. They are used for study cards/note taking. **Bring 25 the first week and keep the rest at home.	3**

PE Attire –

- Students will be advised as to when they will need their PE clothes.

- No spandex or denim (spandex may be worn underneath outer shorts).
- Sweatshirt or warm-up jacket in case of cold weather
- Socks
- Athletic shoes: non-marking soles with ankle support (cross training type).
- Students must have their name printed on their PE clothing. Please put name on hem or neckband of t-shirts and waistband of shorts.
