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2018-2019 Activities & Services Fees

Note: Financial aid and discounts do not apply to student benefits, activities, or services fees.

TRANSPORTATION: TBS transportation runs each school day from the Spanaway-Graham and Gig Harbor areas to TBS. Fees are a flat-rate monthly cost, as you are reserving your child’s seat. Transportation costs are not pro-rated. Transportation fee for the 2018-19 school year is \$125 per month, per student.

SPORTS: \$150 per sport, per season for all participating secondary students
The sports fee is paid each season that a student participates in a sport. (This is not a one-time fee that covers all sports for the entire year). Students will not be permitted to participate in the next season’s sport until the fee from the previous season is paid in full. Students who drop out after the first five practices will be charged 50% of the sports fee. The entire fee will be non-refundable after the first game of the season, even if the student is ineligible to play due to grades.

LUNCH: Hot lunch is available to purchase for \$4.50. Beverages are available at an additional cost. Snacks and a la carte food items are also available for secondary students to purchase. The Student Center serves lunch each full day of school. Lunch service is not available on early dismissal days. Lunch and a la carte items are to be paid for in full at the time of purchase using cash, check, or funds pre-loaded onto the family’s RenWeb account. No lunch items may be charged by students.

INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT CENTER (ISC): This service is available to students in grades 2-12 who meet eligibility requirements pertaining to unique learning needs not met in a standard classroom setting. Diagnostic testing and administrative recommendation are required for placement in ISC. **Please Note:** *ISC is NOT a Title 1 Special Education program. Diagnostic and program fees apply and are billed separately from tuition. For specific pricing, please request an ISC brochure.*

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE (BASC): The cost is \$2.50 per 15 minutes per student or \$15 per hour per family max and is billed separately from tuition. BASC is available before and after school for full-day students in grades PK-6. Before school care is available on normal school days from 7:15-7:45 a.m. and after school care is available from 2:30-5:30 p.m. On early dismissal days, after school care is open until 2:30 p.m. A late fee of \$1.00 per minute per child is assessed if a child is picked up after the scheduled BASC closing time.

ADDITIONAL: There may be additional fees associated with specific courses. AP and some Honors courses are assessed an annual class fee of \$100, which is due in the spring for the following school year. Concurrent Credit and Fine Arts fees may be assessed and are evaluated on a class-by-class basis. All efforts are made to keep these fees as low as possible while still covering expenses.

DISCOUNTS

(Discounts are not combined)

- 10% Discount for Active Military family
- 7% Discount for annual tuition paid in full by 6/1/2018
- 5% Discount for annual tuition paid in full by 7/1/2018
- 3% Discount for annual tuition paid in full by 8/1/2018
- Needs-based financial assistance available to families who qualify. Family must submit an application for assistance through FACTS Grant & Aid
- Full-time pastor family discount is available for those who qualify

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

- MARCH 1** – Early Re-enrollment at \$150/student rate
MARCH 2 – Late Re-enrollment begins at \$300/student with no family max.
JUNE 1 – Financial Assistance Priority Deadline for *returning families* who wish to be considered for financial assistance. Preference is given to those who complete their online re-enrollment and FACTS tuition agreement first.
JUNE 1 – Application deadline for returning families. All *returning students* who apply *after* June 1 will need to pay the late re-enrollment fee, complete an application along with references, and interview as though a new student.
JUNE 1 – Application deadline for students seeking additional resources through our Instructional Support Center (ISC)
AUGUST 1 – Application deadline for all new students who wish to be considered for the start of the 2018-19 school year. This is also the priority deadline for *new families* applying for financial aid.
AUGUST 2 – Late Application Period begins. *Late applications will be accepted, however, the student is not guaranteed to start on the first day of school.* Late applicants will be required to pay the first month’s tuition upon acceptance.
