Admissions at Tacoma Baptist

We are delighted that you are considering Tacoma Baptist Schools for your child! At TBS, we want to walk with you through the admissions process and help you discern if our school is the right fit for your child and family.

The admissions process has three steps beginning with an online application. To start your child's application, go to tacomabaptist.org and click **Apply Now**.

STEP ONE:

- Student / Family Information forms
 - Student Questionnaire (for students entering grades 7-12)
 - Spiritual Life Reference Form (completed by a pastor from the church you are currently attending)
 - Teacher Reference Form (required for students entering grades 1-12)
 - Report Cards (two years, most recent)
 - Standardized Testing results (one year, most recent)
 - IEP, Diagnosis, or 504 documents (if applicable)

STEP TWO:

- Student / Parent Interview with the Principal

STEP THREE:

- Supplemental Forms
 - Medical History/Emergency Contacts
 - Immunizations
 - Parent Agreement
 - FACTS (financial) agreement
