



Attendance/Enrollment Policies for Athletics / Activities

Student Attendance for Practice or Game Participation

A student/athlete must attend all classes to practice or play in a contest. If an athlete is too sick to come to school, they are too sick to practice or play. This does not apply to absences due to a doctor, dental, or similar appointments. Only the principal/athletic director can excuse an absence for participation in a practice or contest. **If a game/contest is on a Saturday, athletes must be at school and practice on Friday!**

Day after Event: In cases of weekday contests, attendance in all classes the following day is expected unless one of the following exceptions applies: 1.) If a team arrives home extremely late from an out of town contest, the athletic director has the discretion to extend the arrival time at school the next day without penalty. 2.) The late arrival is due to a doctor, dental, or similar appointments. 3.) Specific approval by A.D. for individual situation. Failure to comply with these attendance regulations may result in the student athlete being placed on suspension from the next contest.

PRE-SEASON PARENT MEETINGS FOR ATHLETICS:

Before each sport's season (fall, winter, spring), an important pre-season parent meeting is in place to discuss important aspects of athletic policies, specific sport related information, etc. We ask that one parent, grandparent, or guardian is present at this important informational meeting. If an adult cannot attend, please make other arrangements to come in and sign policy requirements and receive information from the athletic director.

ENROLLMENT / SUMMER ATHLETICS

High School students must be fully enrolled at TBS for the upcoming year to be able participate in summer high school athletic opportunities. These summer opportunities begin after the final spring sport state tournament which is considered summer opportunities. To be **fully enrolled**, parents must complete their online enrollment forms and complete all the tasks required under TBS policy.
